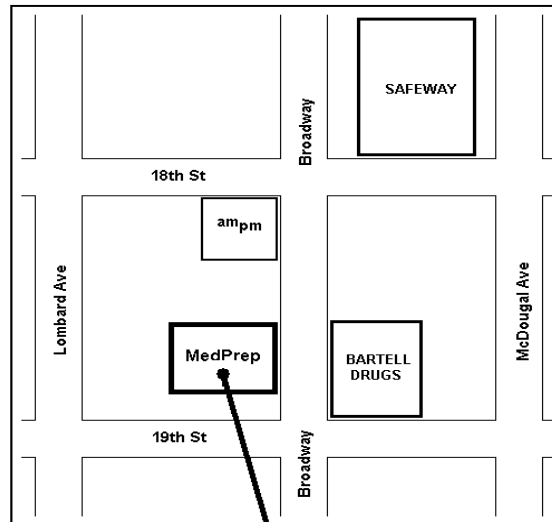
NORTHBOUND I-5

Delivering health care is a very special job that the nursing assistant can take pride in. The NA student will be evaluated through periodic written testing and practical skills demonstrations. This program includes (12) class & (5) internship days; can be Monday through Friday.

ABOUT THE FACILITY

MEDPREP provides a relaxed environment including classroom & patient-care areas, break room area & restroom. The school can adequately accommodate up to thirty students but instead sets a smaller limit for student comfort.

Uniform: Dark navy blue scrub top & pants (no trim colors), closed toe / heel shoes, and a **Personal face mask** (cloth or disposables) & (1-2) boxes of gloves, a watch with a second-hand. (Pricing variable & depends on choices)

CPR (Basic adult CPR certification with introduction, demo & individual use of AED.)

Student can provide current CPR or choose HCP class elsewhere if needed but has to be completed prior to or during the session. (Payable to an independent instructor by cash/ck)

Program Schedule: Choose to attend either **AM** (10:00am- 2:00pm) or **PM** (4:00pm - 8:00pm class.) No weekends; class can be Monday through Friday. Schedule includes (12) class days and (5) clinical internship dates at one of the MEDPREP affiliated nursing homes or other healthcare facilities.

Parking is in a residential area to the east or west of Broadway on 19th Street. No parking in the first block in either direction but okay in the 2nd-4th blocks, either side of the street. Other restrictions apply & to be discussed.

Upon successful completion of the training program there are two independent payments required by the student of \$85.00 for the NA-Certification license application and \$124.00 to schedule the WA.State NA-C written & practice skills examinations.
